









2022 Super High Roller Series Europe

April 2 - 15, 2022

Triton Cyprus is the preceding series to **Super High Roller Series Europe** presented by **Luxon Pay** that includes nine (9) events and **Super High Roller Bowl Europe**. The series is hosted by Merit Poker in North Cyprus. The player that accumulates the most PGT points throughout Super High Roller Series will be awarded the **Super High Roller Series Championship** and a \$25,000 championship bonus.

Triton Cyprus General Rules & Information

- 1. Event #1 has 40-minute levels and late registration through to end of Level 10. 7. The poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop, 25 seconds on the flop, and 30
- 2. Event #2 has 45-minute levels and late registration through to start of Day 2.
- 3. Event #3 has 40-minute levels and late registration through to end of Level 8.
- 4. Event #5 has 45-minute levels and late registration through to start of Level 9.
- 5. All Day 2s will start at 1 p.m. Unofficial final table in Event #2 is nine-handed. Unofficial final table in Event #1, #3, #5, is seven-handed.
- 6. Short Deck events have a reduced fee to 2% on reentries, and all bullets are inplay at start of Level 8.
- 7. The poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop, 25 seconds on the flop, and 30 seconds thereafter. Players will receive 12 time extensions upon registering before first 10 minutes of Level 1. Players will receive five (5) additional time extensions once registration closes. Players will receive five (5) additional time extensions at the final table. A regressive time extension system will apply.
- Level length will be shortened by five (5) minutes when event is down to six players, four players, and heads-up.

Super High Roller Series Europe General Rules & Information

- Players must be in the registration line by the event start time to qualify for any discounts.
- 2. Late entries and re-entries will pay the full tournament fee.
- 3. Entry is open through to the start of Level 7 in NLH and PLO events, and Level 9 in Short Deck events.
- 4. All events are two-day events except for Event #9 which is a one-day event.
- 5. SHR Series Europe is unlimited reentry through to start of Level 7 in NLH and PLO, and start of Level 9 in Short Deck events.
- 6. All bullets must go into play at the start of Level 8 in Short Deck events.
- Levels are 40 minutes with a 10-minute break every two levels. Event #9 will have 30-minute levels.
- 8. There is a 90-minute dinner break at the end of Level 6. Event #9 dinner break will be after Level 9.
- NLH tables are seated 8-handed and switch to 7-handed once registration closes. Unofficial final tables are 9-handed.
- 10. PLO and Short Deck tables are seated 7-handed and switch to 6-handed once registration closes. Unofficial final tables are 7-handed.
- 11. The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with six 30-second time banks for each entry. Unused time banks can be used the next day. The final six (6) players will receive six (6) additional time banks
- 12. Players will play down to the final six players or 13 levels. Day 2 starts at 1 p.m.

Super High Roller Bowl Europe General Rules & Information

- Players must be in the registration line by the event start time to qualify for any discounts.
- 2. This is a three-day event with a single reentry option.
- Late entries and re-entries will have a 2% tournament fee. Registration is open until the start of Level 7.
- Levels are 60 minutes with a 10-minute break every level. There is a 90-minute dinner break after Level 2.
- 5. Players will play six levels on Day 1. Players will play down to the final six on Day 2.
- The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with nine 30-second time banks each day.
 Unused time banks can be used the next day. The final six (6) players will receive six (6) additional time banks

General Rules & Information

- 1. The Super High Roller Series Championship and \$25,000 championship bonus will be awarded to the player that accumulates the most PGT points throughout the nine (9) Super High Roller Series Europe events and Super High Roller Bowl Europe. Points system information can be found on PGT.com/points-system.
- 2. Players at the feature table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Feature table will have at least a 30-minute broadcast delay.
- 3. Players must be 18 years of age to participate.
- 4. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 5. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
