



HIGH ROLLER OF THE YEAR BREAKDOWN

WHAT'S AT STAKE?

- The High Roller of the Year will determine a season-long champion through results in Poker Central's lineup of high stakes events.
- Point multipliers will be applied during major tournaments, adding even more importance to High Roller Triple Crown™ events.
- The player of the year program will award its top, consistent performers with a variety of prizes on an annual basis, including automatic seats into that year's Super High Roller Bowl.

OVERVIEW

After high stakes poker at ARIA Resort & Casino entered into a new era with the debut of the PokerGO Studio, Poker Central has created the first-ever player of the year program made exclusively for High Rollers. The High Roller of the Year award will include results across Poker Central's entire portfolio of high stakes events, including the ARIA High Roller Series and the High Roller Triple Crown™ comprised of the Poker Masters, U.S. Poker Open, and Super High Roller Bowl.

Throughout the year, players earn points on every cash in each event, with point multipliers being applied to larger buy-in events and major tournaments. The High Roller of the Year will award its top, consistent performers with a variety of prizes on an annual basis.

The points leader at the conclusion of the year will receive rake-free entry into all of the following year's ARIA high roller events, and the top five point leaders at the time of the Super High Roller Bowl lottery will receive automatic seats into that year's event. Additional prizing and rewards from Poker Central and their partners will be announced throughout the year.

POINTS BREAKDOWN

The 2019 High Roller of the Year race will kick off with the 2019 U.S. Poker Open on February 13, 2019 and the year-round points race will culminate with Super High Roller Bowl VI. Dates for that event are still to be determined.

Points are awarded for every cash in every event at six levels: 1st: 100 - 2nd: 70 - 3rd: 50 - 4th: 40 - 5th: 30 - All other payouts: 20

Point Multipliers are applied on the following events:

- ARIA High Roller Series events will award 1.0, 1.5, 2.0, 2.5 multipliers on \$10K, \$25K, \$50K, and \$100K events.
- Poker Masters Preliminary events will award 3.0 multipliers, while the Poker Masters Main Event will award a 3.5 multiplier.
- U.S. Poker Open Preliminary events will award 2.0 multipliers, while the U.S. Poker Open Mixed Game Championship and USPO Main Event will award 3.5 multipliers.
- The Super High Roller Bowl will award a 5.0 multiplier.
- World Series of Poker events will also count towards the High Roller of the Year race. WSOP \$25K PLO and \$50K NLH events will
 award a 3.0 multiplier. \$100K NLH and \$50K Poker Players Championship events will award a 3.5 multiplier. WSOP Europe events
 will also award High Roller of the Year points. Those multipliers are still to be determined.
- World Poker Tour events will also count towards the High Roller of the Year race. WPT \$10K NLH High Roller events will award a 2.5 multiplier and \$25K NLH High Roller events will award a 3.0 multiplier.

High Roller of the Year points will be awarded based on tournament results finalized by ARIA Resort & Casino. In the event of any High Roller of the Year leaderboard ties, total earnings will be used as a tiebreaker.
