



2022 PGT Championship

December 21-22, 2022

The **PGT Championship** is an invitational freeroll for the top 21 players on the PGT Leaderboard with the winner receiving \$500,000. Players starting stacks will be based on PGT points earned in 2022.

General Rules & Information

- 1. The entire PGT Championship will be streamed on PokerGO.com.
- 2. Entry is open to the top 21 players on the PGT leaderboard as of December 21, 2022.
- 3. Day 1 starts at 12 p.m. PT and will play down to the final table of six.
- 4. Day 2 starts at 12 p.m. PT and will play down to the winner who will receive \$500,000 in prize money.
- Starting stacks will be determined by PGT points earned in 2022.
- 6. Players will have until the start of Level 3 to be seated.
- Players chips will not be in play, but for each 15-minutes
 of play missed, they will have one orbit of blinds and
 antes removed from their stack. Players will draw into a
 table and will not start playing until they are in the big
 blind.
- 8. Levels are 45 minutes with a 10-minute break every two levels.
- 9. Tables are seated 7-handed and play begins with the standard PGT Seat Draw.
- 10. Unofficial final table is 9-handed.
- 11. The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with ten 30-second time banks. The final six (6) players will receive six (6) additional time banks.
- 12. Players at the feature table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Feature table will have at least a 30-minute broadcast delay.
- 13. Phones and tablets will be collected from players and only be returned during breaks, or once eliminated.
- 14. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- 15. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 16. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.

PGT Championship Starting Stacks

For every 10 PGT points, players will earn 1,000 chips. For example:

- 1,255 PGT points = 126,000 starting chips
- 2,179 PGT points = 218,000 starting chips
- 3,984 PGT points = 399,000 starting chips
