



2023 PGT Championship

January 9-10, 2023

The **PGT Championship** is a \$1,000,000 freeroll for the top 40 players on the PGT Leaderboard and select Dream Seat winners. Players starting stacks will be based on PGT points earned in the 2023 season.

General Rules & Information

1. The entire PGT Championship will be streamed on PokerGO.com.
2. Entry is open to the top 40 players on the PGT leaderboard as of January 8, 2024, and select "Dream Seat" winners.
3. Day 1 starts at 12 p.m. PT and will play down to the final table of six.
4. Day 2 starts at 12 p.m. PT and will play down to the winner who will receive \$500,000 in prize money.
5. Starting stacks will be determined by PGT points earned during the 2023 season.
6. Players will have until the start of Level 4 to be seated.
7. Players chips will not be in play, but for each 20-minutes of play missed, they will have one orbit of blinds and antes removed from their stack. Players will draw into a table and will not start playing until they are in the big blind.
8. Levels are 40 minutes with a break every three levels.
9. Tables are seated 7-handed and play begins with the standard PGT Seat Draw. Dream Seat winners from non-playing promotions will be evenly distributed across starting tables.
10. Single table redraw will be with eight (8) players remaining.
11. The poker shot clock is 30 seconds with ten 30-second time banks. The final six (6) players will receive six (6) additional time banks.
12. Players at the feature table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Feature table will have at least a 30-minute broadcast delay.
13. Phones and tablets will be collected from final table players and only be returned during breaks, or once eliminated.
14. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
15. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
16. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.

PGT Championship Starting Stacks

For every 10 PGT points, players will earn 1,000 chips. For example:

- 1,255 PGT points = 126,000 starting chips
- 2,179 PGT points = 218,000 starting chips
- 3,984 PGT points = 399,000 starting chips

Note: Minimum starting stack is 100 big blinds.
