General Rules & Information

- The buy-in for Super High Roller Bowl: Pot-Limit Omaha is \$100,000.
- Players must be in the registration line by 1 p.m. PT to qualify for any discounts.
- Rake for on-time entry is \$500, while all late entries and reentries will pay the full tournament fee of \$3,000.
- Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 (approximately 1 p.m. PT on Day 2 - Friday, October 25).
- Starting stack is 300,000 in chips.
- Levels are 60 minutes with a 10-minute break every two levels.
- Day 1 will play 8 levels. Day 2 will play down to the final five players. Day 3 will play to a winner.
- Tables are seated 7-handed and single table redraw will be with seven (7) players remaining.
- There will be a full tournament redraw when registration closes at the start of Day 2, when seven players remain, and at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
- The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Players will receive nine 30-second time extensions if entering prior to the second break, and six 30-second time extensions if entering after level four. Players will receive an additional nine at the start of Day 2, and an additional six at the start of the final table.
- Payouts will be posted once registration is closed and will pay one-in-six entries according to the standard PGT payout structure.
- Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
