The **Texas PLO Roundup** is a series of nine events with players earning PGT points in the Texas PLO Roundup Main Event and three PGT High Rollers. The top 40 eligible players as ranked by the PGT leaderboard at the end of the season will qualify for the season-ending PGT Championship \$1,000,000 freeroll.

General Rules & Information

- 1. The Texas PLO Roundup is hosted at Champions Club Texas in partnership with PokerGO and the PGT. Players will earn PGT points in events with buy-ins of \$3,000+.
- 2. Players will receive a \$30 food voucher for every Texas PLO Roundup High Roller entry to use at the in-house restaurant.
- Players must be in the registration line at the scheduled start time 3. to qualify for any discounts.
- 4. Late entries and reentries will pay the full tournament fee.
- Texas PLO Roundup High Rollers are one-day events. Day 1 starts at 5. 6 p.m. CT and plays to a winner. Levels are 20 minutes in duration.
- 6. Entry in Texas Poker Open High Rollers are open to the start of Level 9. Players are allowed unlimited reentries in each event.
- 7. Tables are seated 8-handed and switch to 7-handed no later than close of registration.
- 8. Single table redraw will be with seven (7) players remaining.
- 9. Tournament Director has discretion to add or remove breaks and alter break time if necessary.
- 10. The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Time extensions will be distributed according to entry point in the tournament; before first break (8), any point thereafter (6). Additional time extensions will be distributed to players in the money if the field exceeds 71 entrants (2) or 85 entrants (3). The final seven (7) players will receive six (6) additional time extensions.
- 11. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- 12. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 13. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.

Texas PLO Roundup High Rollers Payouts

Payout will be posted once registration is closed and will pay one-inseven entries according to the standard PGT payout structure. PGT points are calculated in accordance with the PGT points system found on PGT.com/points.

Note: Big Blind Ante is posted after the Big Blind and is the difference between the small and big blind – but equal to a full big blind when heads-up. The big blind ante is included in preflop pot calculation and the maximum opening raise with no prior action, regardless of position, is four times the amount of the big blind.
