General Rules & Information

- 1. The <u>Texas Poker Open Main Event</u> is hosted at <u>Champions Club Texas</u> in partnership with PokerGO and the PGT. Players will earn PGT points based on the amount the cash for (more information on the PGT points system can be found at PGT.com/points).
- 2. The buy-in is \$3,300 with \$3,000 to the prize pool, \$200 to the access fee, and \$100 to the staff fee. The prize pool guarantee is \$2,000,000.
- 3. The starting stack is 60,000 in chips.
- 4. Registration is open until the start of Level 13 in all Day 1 flights. Players are allowed unlimited reentries and must be eliminated or surrender their chip stack to reenter.
- 5. Day 1 levels will be 40 minutes with a break every three levels. Day 1 turbo flight levels will be 20 minutes with a break every six levels.
- 6. Day 2 will be 60-minute levels and will begin at the earliest point in the tournament where a Day 1 flight ended excluding the turbo flights.
- 7. Final Table levels will be 60 minutes. Once heads-up play is reached at the final table, levels will be reduced to 30 minutes.
- 8. Tournament Director has discretion to add or remove breaks and alter break time if necessary.
- 9. Day 1 flights will play to the money of approximately 12% of the field.
- 10. Day 2 will introduce the PGT shot clock which is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Players will receive eight (8) time extensions worth 30-seconds each. Players will receive an additional six (6) time extensions with 24 players remaining and once the final table is set.
- 11. Tables are seated 9-handed and switch to 8-handed no later than close of registration.
- 12. Day 2 redraws will occur with 24 players, 16 players, and 9 players remaining. Day 2 concludes once final table of nine is set.
- 13. The Texas Poker Open Main Event will be streamed daily on PokerGO.com, and players at the feature table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand.
- 14. The Texas Poker Open Main Event will be live reported on **PGT.com**.
- 15. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- 16. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 17. Champions Club reserves the right to void any entry, and/or to change, cancel or modify this tournament at any time.
