The **U.S. Poker Open** is a series of eight (8) events with the player who earns the most PGT points awarded the U.S. Poker Open Golden Eagle Trophy. and the \$25,000 PGT Passport bonus. The top 40 eligible players as ranked by the PGT leaderboard at the end of the season will qualify for the season-ending **PGT Championship \$1,000,000 freeroll**.

General Rules & Information

- The U.S. Poker Open Golden Eagle Trophy and PGT Passport \$25,000 bonus will be awarded by the PGT to the player that accumulates the most PGT points. PGT Passports can be used for PGT-owned and operated events and cannot be assigned, transferred, or withdrawn for cash. Players must cash in two events to be eligible. ARIA is not responsible for the administration of or calculations determining the championship bonus.
- 2. Players must be in the registration line by 12 p.m. PT to qualify for any discounts.
- 3. Late entries and reentries will pay the full tournament fee.
- 4. All events are two-day events, and both days start at the same time as listed above.
- 5. Event #1 will be 30-minute levels with a break every four levels while registration is open, and every three levels thereafter. Entry is open until the start of Level 9 (~4:30 p.m. PT). There will be an added 1,500/2,500 level as Level 4, and the 2,500/5,000 will be a double level. Players are allowed two reentries.
- Events #2-7 will be 40-minute levels with a break every three levels while registration is open, and every two levels thereafter. Entry is open until the start of Level 7 (~4:30 p.m. PT). Players are allowed two reentries.
- 7. Event #8 will be 45-minute levels with a break every two levels. Entry is open until the start of Level 7 (~7 p.m. PT). Players are allowed two reentries.
- 8. The Event #6 final table will be played on Monday, April 15, at 12 p.m. PT.
- 9. Tables are seated 8-handed and switch to 7-handed no later than close of registration.
- 10. Single table redraw will be with seven (7) players remaining.
- 11. Tournament Director has discretion to add or remove breaks.
- 12. The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Time extensions will be distributed according to entry point in the tournament; before first break (8), any point thereafter (6). Additional time extensions will be distributed to players in the money if the field exceeds 71 entrants (2) or 85 entrants (3). The final seven (7) players will receive six (6) additional time extensions.
- 13. Players will play down to the final six players or to through Level 16. When heads-up play is reached, levels will be reduced to 30 minutes.
- Players at the feature table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Feature table will have at least a 30-minute broadcast delay and be livestreamed on PokerGO.
- 15. Phones and tablets will be collected for players at the feature table and only be returned during breaks, or once eliminated.
- 16. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 18. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
