

2025 PGT PLO Series II

October 14-25, 2025



The **PGT PLO Series II** is a series of 10 events with the player who earns the most PGT points awarded the \$10,000 PGT Passport. The top 40 eligible players as ranked by the PGT leaderboard at the end of the season will qualify for the season-ending **PGT \$1,000,000 Championship freeroll**.

General Rules & Information

- The PGT PLO Series \$10,000 PGT Passport bonus will be awarded by the PGT to the player that
 accumulates the most PGT points. PGT Passport can be used for PGT-owned and operated events and
 cannot be assigned, transferred, or withdrawn for cash. Players must cash in two events to be eligible.
 ARIA is not responsible for the administration of or calculations determining the championship bonus.
- 2. All events are 7-handed but will play 8-handed if necessary while registration is open. Single table redraw at seven (7) players.
- 3. Late entries and reentries will pay the full tournament fee.
- 4. Events #1-9 are two-day events and Day 2 restarts will be at 11:45 a.m. PT.
- 5. Events #1-3 will be 30-minute levels with a break every four levels. Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 (~4:45 p.m.).
- Events #4-6 will be 30-minute levels with a break every four levels. Entry is open through to the start
 of Level 9 (~4:45 p.m.). 40-minute levels begin from Level 13 onwards.
- 7. Events #7-9 will be 30-minute levels with a break every four levels. Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 (~4:45 p.m.). 40-minute levels begin from Level 9 onwards.
- 8. The \$25,000 Pot-Limit Omaha Championship will be 45-minute levels while registration is open, and then 60-minutes thereafter with breaks every two levels. Entry is open through to the start of Level 7 (~5:15 p.m.) and Day 1 will end after 12 levels. Levels 1 and 7 will be omitted from structure.
- Events #1-9 will play down to the final six players or 1:30 a.m. PT. When three-handed play is reached, levels lengths will be reduced at the Tournament Director's discretion.
- 10. If the final table runs past the end of registration in the next event, players still playing at the final table will be allowed one additional level to register for the next event.
- 11. The Event #5 final table will be played on Monday, October 20, at 11:45 a.m. PT.
- 12. Event #2 will see \$3,000 to the prize pool and \$2,000 towards bounties. Bounties begin with 25% of the field remaining, and any additional bounty money will be awarded as the final bounty.
- 13. Event #5 will see \$6,000 to the prize pool and \$4,000 towards progressive bounties.
- 14. Event #8 will see \$10,000 to the prize pool and \$5,000 towards mystery bounties.
- 15. All events are unlimited reentry except for the \$25,000 Pot-Limit Omaha Championship which will allow players a max of two reentries.
- 16. The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Time extensions will be distributed according to entry point in the tournament; before first break, any point thereafter \$5k (6/4), \$10k/\$15k (8/6), and \$25k (10/8). Additional time extensions may be distributed for Progressive Bounty events, and to players in the money if the field exceeds 71 entrants (2) or 85 entrants (3). The final seven (7) players will receive six (6) additional time extensions.
- 17. Tournament Director has discretion to add or remove breaks.
- 18. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- 19. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Players are required to accept payment for all tournament payouts within 60 days of the conclusion of the event in which the payout was awarded.
- 20. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
