General Rules & Information

- 1. Players must be in the registration line by start time to qualify for any discounts. All late entries will pay the full tournament fee.
- Players are allowed a single reentry in Super High Roller Bowl: Pot-Limit Omaha and unlimited reentries in Super High Roller Series \$15k events.
- Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 in all events. For SHRB, that will be the start of Day 2. For the SHRS \$15k events, that will be the end of second break.
- Starting stacks in Super High Roller Bowl is 300,000 in chips. Starting stacks in the SHRS \$15ks are 125,000.
- 5. Levels in Super High Roller Bowl are 60 minutes with a 10-minute break every two levels. Levels in the \$15k are 30-minutes with an inserted 1,500/2,500 and a repeat 2,500/5,000 level.
- Super High Roller Bowl will play eight levels on Day 1, and down to five players on Day 2. The \$15ks are one-day events and will play to a winner.
- Tables are seated 7-handed and single table redraw will be with seven (7) players remaining.
- 8. For Super High Roller Bowl, there will be a full tournament redraw when registration closes at the start of Day 2, when seven players remain, and at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
- 9. The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Players will receive nine 30-second time extensions if entering prior to the second break, and six 30-second time extensions if entering after level four. Players will receive an additional nine at the start of Day 2, and an additional six at the start of the final table.
- 10. Payouts will be posted once registration is closed and will pay one-in-six entries according to the standard PGT payout structure.
- 11. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- 12. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Players are required to accept payment for all tournament payouts within 60 days of the conclusion of the event in which the payout was awarded.
- 13. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
