



2025 Texas Poker Open



April 16-29, 2025

The **Texas Poker Open** is a series of 21 events with players earning PGT points in the Texas Poker Open Main Event and four PGT High Rollers. The top 40 eligible players as ranked by the PGT leaderboard at the end of the season will qualify for the season-ending **PGT Championship \$1,000,000 freeroll**.

General Rules & Information

- The Texas Poker Open is hosted at Champions Club Texas in partnership with PokerGO and the PGT. Players will earn PGT points based on the amount they cash for in events with buy-ins of \$3,000 or more.
- Players will receive a \$30 food voucher for every Texas Poker Open High Roller entry to use at the in-house restaurant.
- Players must be in the registration line at the scheduled start time to qualify for any discounts.
- Late entries and reentries will pay the full tournament fee. Players are allowed unlimited reentries.
- All events are one-day events and play to a winner.
- Events #1-3 will start at 6 p.m. CT. Event #4 will start at 2 p.m. CT. Levels are 20 minutes in duration.
- Entry in Texas Poker Open High Rollers are open to the start of Level 9.
- Tables are seated 8-handed and switch to 7-handed no later than close of registration.
- Single table redraw will be with seven (7) players remaining.
- Tournament Director has discretion to add or remove breaks and alter break time if necessary.
- The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Time extensions will be distributed according to entry point in the tournament; before first break (6), any point thereafter (4). Additional time extensions will be distributed to players in the money if the field exceeds 71 entrants (2) or 85 entrants (3). The final seven (7) players will receive six (6) additional time extensions.
- Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.

Texas Poker Open High Rollers Payouts

Payout will be posted once registration is closed and will pay one-in-seven entries according to the standard PGT payout structure. PGT points are calculated in accordance with the PGT points system found on PGT.com/points.
