The **U.S. Poker Open** is a series of eight (8) events with the player who earns the most PGT points awarded the U.S. Poker Open Golden Eagle Trophy and the \$25,000 PGT Passport bonus. The top 40 eligible players as ranked by the PGT leaderboard at the end of the season will qualify for the season-ending **PGT Championship \$1,000,000 freeroll**.

General Rules & Information

- The U.S. Poker Open Golden Eagle Trophy and PGT Passport \$25,000 bonus will be awarded by the PGT to the player that accumulates the most PGT points. PGT Passports can be used for PGT-owned and operated events and cannot be assigned, transferred, or withdrawn for cash. Players must cash in two events to be eligible. ARIA is not responsible for the administration of or calculations determining the championship bonus.
- 2. Players must be in the registration line by the start of play to qualify for any discounts.
- 3. Late entries and reentries will pay the full tournament fee. Players are allowed two reentries maximum.
- 4. All events are two-day events. Day 2 restarts for Events #1-7 will be 11:45 a.m. PT.
- Event #1 will be 30-minute levels with a break every four levels. Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 (~4:45 p.m.).
- 6. Events #2-5 will be 30-minute levels with a break every four levels. Entry is open through the start of Level 9 (~4:45 p.m.). 40-minute levels begin from Level 13 onwards.
- 7. Events #6-7 will be 30-minute levels with a break every four levels. Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 (~4:45 p.m.). 40-minute levels begin from Level 9 onwards.
- 8. Event #8 will be 45-minute levels with a break every two levels. Entry is open until the start of Level 7 (~6 p.m.).
- 9. The Event #5 final table will be played on Monday, April 14, at 11:45 a.m. PT.
- 10. Tables are seated 8-handed and switch to 7-handed no later than close of registration.
- 11. Single table redraw will be with seven (7) players remaining.
- 12. Tournament Director has discretion to add or remove breaks.
- 13. The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Time extensions will be distributed according to entry point in the tournament; before first break, any point thereafter \$5k (6/4), \$10k/\$15k (8/6), and \$25k (10/8). Additional time extensions may be distributed to players in the money if the field exceeds 71 entrants (2) or 85 entrants (3). The final seven (7) players will receive six (6) additional time extensions.
- 14. Players will play down to the final six players or to through Level 16. When three-handed play is reached, level lengths will be reduced at the Tournament Director's discretion.
- 15. If the final table runs past the end of registration in the next event, players still playing at the final table will be allowed one additional level to register for the next event.
- 16. Players at the feature table are required to place their hole cards in the RFID box at the start of each hand. Feature table will have at least a 30-minute broadcast delay and be livestreamed on PokerGO.
- Phones and tablets will be collected for players at the feature table and only be returned during breaks, or once eliminated.
- 18. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- 19. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 20. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
