



# 2026 PGT Kickoff

## January 26-31, 2026

The **PGT Kickoff** is a series of six (6) events with players earning double points for all cashes. The top 40 eligible players as ranked by the PGT leaderboard at the end of the season will qualify for the season-ending **PGT Championship freeroll**.

**Kickoff the start of the 2025 PGT season by earning DOUBLE POINTS for all cashes during PGT Kickoff!**

### General Rules & Information

1. Players must be in the registration line by the start of play to qualify for any discounts.
2. Late entries and reentries will pay the full tournament fee.
3. The first five events are two-day events and unlimited reentry. Final tables will conclude the following day at 12 p.m. PT and will be livestreamed on PokerGO.
4. Levels are 30 minutes with a break every four levels while registration is open, and every three levels thereafter. Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 (approximately 5:30 p.m. PT).
5. Event #6 will be a single-day event and be the 20-20 turbo format of 20-minute levels and a 20 second shot clock with 20 second time extensions.
6. Tables are seated 8-handed and switch to 7-handed no later than close of registration.
7. Single table redraw will be with seven (7) players remaining.
8. Tournament Director has discretion to add or remove breaks.
9. The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Time extensions will be distributed according to entry point in the tournament; before first break (8), any point thereafter (6). Additional time extensions will be distributed to players in the money if the field exceeds 71 entrants (2) or 85 entrants (3). The final seven (7) players will receive six (6) additional time extensions.
10. Players will play down to the final six players or through Level 16. When heads-up play is reached, levels will be reduced to 20 minutes.
11. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
12. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
13. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.

### PGT Kickoff Payouts

Payouts will be posted once registration is closed and will pay one-in-seven entries according to the standard PGT payout structure. PGT Points are calculated in accordance with the PGT points system found on [PGT.com/points](https://www.pgt.com/points).

Players will earn **DOUBLE POINTS** at a rate of 0.002 PGT points per dollar cashed during PGT Kickoff.
