1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Venetian Rewards card to participate.
3. Fifteen (15) minute break at completion of every three (3) levels.
4. Each starting flight will play until we are down to approximately 12.5% of the field remaining. A Feature table will be streamed each starting day. Day 2, we resume at 11:00 AM combining all remaining players from 1A, 1B, and 1C with all players being considered in the money and will continue until we reach the final seven players. To begin Day 2, the clock will revert to the earliest stoppage time of Day 1. Day 3 will resume at 11:00 AM for a produced streamed final table by PokerGO.
5. Management reserves the right to cancel or change the tournament.
6. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
7. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
8. \$300 of the \$3,300 Buy-In is withheld for house fees (Rake + Staff). The prize pool consists of \$3,000 of every \$3,300 Buy In. Players who register before 11:10 AM will receive a \$200 discount of house fees for a total buy in of \$3,100 only. Once the event has started each day, a buy in of \$3,300 is all for late entry and re-entry.
9. Reg and Re-Entry is allowed for nine (9) levels and through the break.
10. Players who bag chips for Day 2 may not play a subsequent flight.
11. Ante will come from the Big Blind Only. Big Blind is posted before Ante.
12. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
13. This event will play seven (7) handed.
14. All pre-registered stacks will be in play at the start of the event.
15. Day 2 will introduce the PGT shot clock which is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds post flop. Players will receive six (6) time extensions worth 30 seconds each. Players will receive an additional six (6) time extensions with 21 players remaining and once the final table is set. In the case that time expires for a player with remaining time-extension chips, the player's countdown clock will automatically extend an additional thirty (30) seconds. Collection of time-extension chips will take place at the end of the player's action. If a player's countdown clock expires and the player does not have any time-extension chips remaining, he/she will be (a) forced to check, if there is no bet pending or (b) fold, if facing a bet or raise.
16. Players receive PGT points for an in-the-money finish. PGT points determine position on the PGT leaderboard which qualifies players for the PGT \$1,000,000 Championship freeroll. PGT points will be scored at a rate of 0.001 per dollar cashed in the PGT Venetian Las Vegas Classic.
