PGT PLO Series is an official PGT series consisting of 8 events. All tournaments award PGT points. The player who earns the most PGT points during the series will be crowned PGT PLO Series champion and win a \$10,000 PGT Passport bonus. The top 40 eligible players on the final PGT leaderboard may qualify for the season-ending PGT Championship.

General Rules & Information

- The PGT PLO Series trophy and a \$10,000 PGT Passport are awarded to the player who earns the most PGT points. Players must cash in at least two events to be eligible. PGT Passports may be used only for PGT-owned and operated events, are non-transferable, and are not redeemable for cash. ARIA is not responsible for administering or calculating series awards.
- Players must be in the registration line by the start time to receive any applicable discount.
- Late registrations and re-entries pay the full tournament fee; Events #1-7 offer unlimited re-entry, and Event #8 is limited to two re-entries per player.
- All events are two-day tournaments. Day 1 plays to the final table and Day 2 to a winner. PGT and ARIA reserve the right to modify the schedule.
- The series is off Sun, Sep 27. The Event #3 final table will be played on Mon, Sep 28.
- Events #1-2 feature 30-minute levels throughout. Breaks every four levels.
 - Registration for Events #1-2 closes at the start of Level 9.
- Events #3-5 feature 30-minute levels through Level 12, followed by 40-minute levels. Breaks every four levels through Level 12, then every three levels, or as directed by the Tournament Director.
 - Registration for Events #3-5 closes at the start of Level 9.
- Events #6-7 feature 30-minute levels through Level 8, then 40-minute levels thereafter starting with Level 9. Breaks every four levels through Level 8 and every three levels thereafter.
 - Registration for Events #6-7 closes at the start of Level 9.
- Event #8 features 45-minute levels through Level 8, then 60-minute levels thereafter, with breaks every two levels.
 - Level 1 and Level 7 are removed from the Event #8 structure. The event begins with the 1,000/1,500/1,500 level.
 - Registration for Event #8 closes at the start of Level 9.
- The Tournament Director may adjust breaks at their discretion.
- Event #4: \$6,000 from each buy-in goes to the prize pool and \$4,000 to quattro bounties. Bounties begin with 25% of the field remaining, and any additional bounty money will be awarded as the final bounty.
- Event #6: \$10,000 from each buy-in goes to the prize pool and \$5,000 to mystery bounties.
- Big blind ante is posted after the big blind.
- Tables begin 8-handed and transition to 7-handed as soon as practical.
- A single-table redraw occurs with seven players remaining.
- The PGT Poker Clock uses 20-second preflop and 30-second postflop action clocks. Time extensions are distributed by buy-in and registration point: \$5,000 (6/4), \$10,000/\$15,000 (8/6), and \$25,000 (10/8). If the field exceeds 71 entrants, players in the money receive two additional time extensions. If the field exceeds 85 entrants, players in the money receive three additional time extensions. The final seven players each receive six additional time extensions.
- Day 1 play continues until six players remain, unless otherwise determined by the Tournament Director.
- Once play reaches three-handed, level lengths may be reduced at the Tournament Director's discretion.
- If a final table extends beyond registration for the next event, players still competing may register one additional level late.
- Players at the feature table must place their hole cards in the RFID reader at the start of each hand.
- Phones and tablets must be surrendered at the final table.
- Players must be at least 21 years of age to participate.
- Residents of countries without a U.S. tax treaty are subject to applicable tax withholding. Tournament payouts must be claimed within 60 days of the event.
- Management reserves the right to modify or cancel any tournament.
- Prize payouts are posted after registration closes. Events pay approximately one in seven entries and award PGT points under the official PGT points system at PGT.com/points.
